Emergency Cash and Document Checklist

Emergency Contacts:

Contact List: List of important contacts including family, friends, doctors, and financial advisors.

Local Emergency Numbers: Police, fire, and medical emergency numbers.

Medical Documents:

Health Insurance Cards: Copies or digital photos of cards.

Immunization Records: For all family members.

Prescription Medication List: Including dosages and prescribing doctors.

Medical Power of Attorney: Document designating someone to make medical decisions on your behalf.

Identification Documents:

Passports: Keep current passports for all family members.

Driver's Licenses: Up-to-date licenses for all driving family members.

Birth Certificates: Originals or certified copies for all family members.

Social Security Cards: Originals or copies for all family members.

Legal Documents:

Wills: Current wills for all adult family members.

Power of Attorney: Legal document designating someone to act on your behalf.

Marriage Certificates: Originals or certified copies.

Emergency Cash:

Cash Reserve: Keep a reserve of cash in small denominations for basic necessities.

Emergency Fund: Save 3 to 6 months' worth of living expenses in an easily accessible account.

Hidden Cash Stash: Have a hidden stash of cash for extreme emergencies.

Financial Documents:

Bank Account Information: Account numbers, routing numbers, and bank contact information.

Credit and Debit Cards: At least one backup card in case of loss or theft.

Investment Documents: Account numbers and contact information for all investment accounts.

Insurance Policies: Copies of health, auto, homeowners, and life insurance policies.

Property Documents:

Home Title or Lease Agreement: Proof of ownership or rental agreement.

Vehicle Titles and Registrations: For all owned vehicles.

Utility Bills: Recent bills to prove residence if needed.

Digital Security:

Password List: A secure list of important passwords.

Digital Copies: Encrypted digital copies of all important documents on a secure USB drive.

Miscellaneous:

Recent Photos: Of all family members for identification purposes.

Pet Documents: Vaccination records and identification for all pets.

Storage:

Safe Deposit Box: For storing originals of important documents.

Waterproof Document Holder: For keeping copies of important documents at home.

Digital Storage: Secure cloud storage or encrypted digital storage for copies of documents.

Educational Resources:

Financial Preparedness Guide: For managing finances and documents in emergencies.

Home Schooling: Extra copy of school work (if applicable)
