

Survival Gardening Tools Checklist

Basic Hand Tools:

Garden Trowel: For digging small holes and transplanting.

Hand Pruner: For trimming and cutting small branches.

Garden Fork: For loosening soil and aerating.

Weeder: For removing unwanted plants.

Garden Hoe: For shaping soil and controlling weeds.

Cultivator: For loosening soil and removing weeds.

Spade: For digging and edging.

Garden Rake: For leveling soil and clearing debris.

Long-Handled Tools:

Shovel: For digging, lifting, and moving material.

Bow Rake: For spreading mulch and leveling soil.

Garden Fork (long-handled): For turning soil and compost.

Mattock or Pickaxe: For breaking up hard soil.

Loppers: For cutting thicker branches.

Watering Tools:

Watering Can: For hand watering plants.

Garden Hose with Nozzle: For watering large areas.

Soaker Hose or Drip Irrigation System: For efficient watering.

Rain Barrel: For collecting rainwater.

Composting Tools:

Compost Bin or Tumbler: For composting kitchen and garden waste.

Compost Fork or Pitchfork: For turning compost.

Planting Tools:

Seed Planter: For precise seed planting.

Bulb Planter: For planting bulbs.

Trellises or Stakes: For supporting growing plants.

Netting: to protect fruits and berries from birds.

Protection and Maintenance:

Garden Gloves: For hand protection.

Knee Pads or Kneeling Pad: For knee protection.

Wheelbarrow or Garden Cart: For transporting soil and materials.

Garden Tool Organizer or Shed: For tool storage.

Tool Sharpener: For keeping blades sharp.

Soil Testing and Amendment:

Soil Test Kit: For testing soil pH and nutrients.

Fertilizer Spreader: For evenly distributing fertilizer.

Pest and Weed Control:

Hand Sprayer: For applying pesticides or herbicides.

Flame Weeder: For organic weed control.

Harvesting Tools:

Garden Scissors or Snips: For harvesting herbs and vegetables.

Harvesting Basket: For collecting produce.

Seeds and Propagation:

Heirloom Seeds: For planting.
