When moving to a new area, it is advisable to start a list of these important resources for the new area. This will help you familiarize yourself with the resources available to you so if or when you need them you will at least know they are there.

Water Sources:

Local Rivers, Lakes, and Streams: Map out accessible water bodies.

Public Wells and Water Points: Locations and operating hours.

Rainwater Collection Sites: Suitable locations for collecting rainwater.

Food Sources:

Local Farms and Markets: Locations, operating hours, and available produce.

Food Banks and Community Kitchens: Addresses and operating hours.

Edible Wild Plants: Identification guide and locations where they can be found.

Medical Facilities and Supplies:

Hospitals and Clinics: Locations, contact information, and services offered.

Pharmacies: Locations and operating hours.

Health Departments: Locations, services offered, and vaccination clinics.

Shelter and Warmth:

Emergency Shelters: Locations and contact information.

Homeless Shelters and Services: Addresses and operating hours.

Firewood Suppliers: Locations, pricing, and delivery options.

Fuel and Power:

Gas Stations: Locations and operating hours.

Propane Suppliers: Locations, pricing, and delivery options.

Solar Equipment Suppliers: Locations and types of solar equipment available.

Security and Law Enforcement:

Police Stations: Locations and contact information.

Neighborhood Watch Groups: Contact information and meeting schedules.

Legal Aid Services: Locations, contact information, and services offered.

Educational Resources:

Schools and Educational Facilities: Locations and types of education offered.

Vocational Training Centers: Locations, courses offered, and enrollment information.

Outdoor Survival Training: Locations, courses offered, and pricing.

Community Organizations:

Local Nonprofits and Charities: Locations, services offered, and volunteer opportunities.

Religious Organizations: Locations, service times, and community services offered.

Support Groups: Types, meeting schedules, and contact information.

Recreational Areas:

Parks and Natural Reserves: Locations, amenities, and allowed activities.

Gyms and Sports Facilities: Locations, pricing, and available facilities.

Community Gardens: Locations, plot availability, and contact information.

Important Contacts:

Emergency Numbers: Local emergency contact numbers for quick reference.

Key Community Contacts: Names, roles, and contact information of important community members.
